1. Tournament Organiser is Andrew Bullen 0407 075 623. The carnival will be conducted under the control of the carnival organiser, whose decision on all matters will be final.
2. Ropes/Barriers will be placed to separate the playing area from the spectators. Replacement players, coaches, team managers are allowed inside. Spectators are to remain outside the roped off barrier at all times.
3. For Under 6s through to Under 9s - The team listed first is required to supply the referee for the game. For Under 10s through to Under 12s - The team list first is required to supply the referee for the following (proceeding) game. The first game of the day for each of these grades will be refereed by Dalby (see draw).
4. The carnival will commence at 8.30am and be completed by 2pm.
5. Start times will be controlled by a field marshall with a hooter. There are no breaks between games. **The end hooter is also the start hooter**, so the next team must be ready to run on as soon as the hooter goes. Teams should move from the field immediately once the game has concluded to allow for the next game to commence.
6. The canteen will be operating in the rugby clubhouse. The BBQ, Cake Stall and coffee van will operate between the junior oval and AFL oval (see map) from 8am-1pm approx.
7. There are two first aid stations – between the main oval and junior field and beside the AFL oval. An ambulance will also be onsite.
8. Toilet facilities are located at our clubhouse, the AFL clubhouse and on the hill between our main oval and the rugby league grounds (see map).
9. Please respect our grounds and the grounds of our neighbouring football codes by picking up all your rubbish before your team departs a field.

stop poor sideline behaviour in junior sport

Aussie kids love sport!
1.7 million aged 5-14 years participate¹

that's **60%**

Sport is generally a positive experience for most kids, but... **75%**

A UK study showed that 75% of children who participated in organised sport up to the age of 16 had been criticised for their performance, had been shouted or sworn at or had been embarrassed or humiliated by a coach, parent, peer or sports administrator.²

Australian research shows that aggressive behaviour on the sidelines is embarrassing junior footballers, making them lose confidence and can lead to them quitting the sport.³

Here's what they want from sport

1. To have fun.
2. To do something they're good at.
3. To improve their skills.
4. To stay in shape.
5. To get exercise.⁴

Poor sideline behaviour causes kids ...

1. To lose confidence
2. Unfair criticism
3. Embarrassment
4. To feel threatened
5. To avoid making mistakes
6. To drop out of the team/sport
7. To avoid making mistakes

How to recognise poor behaviour

1. Emphasis on winning/results
2. Abuse/intimidation of coaches/officials
3. Excessive instruction from the sideline
4. Putting down children in front of others
5. Criticise performances on the drive home

Positive Things we can do

- Respect all athletes, coaches and officials
- Support, encourage and praise efforts
- Be enthusiastic and positive
- Emphasise fun and enjoyment
- Be quiet and listen

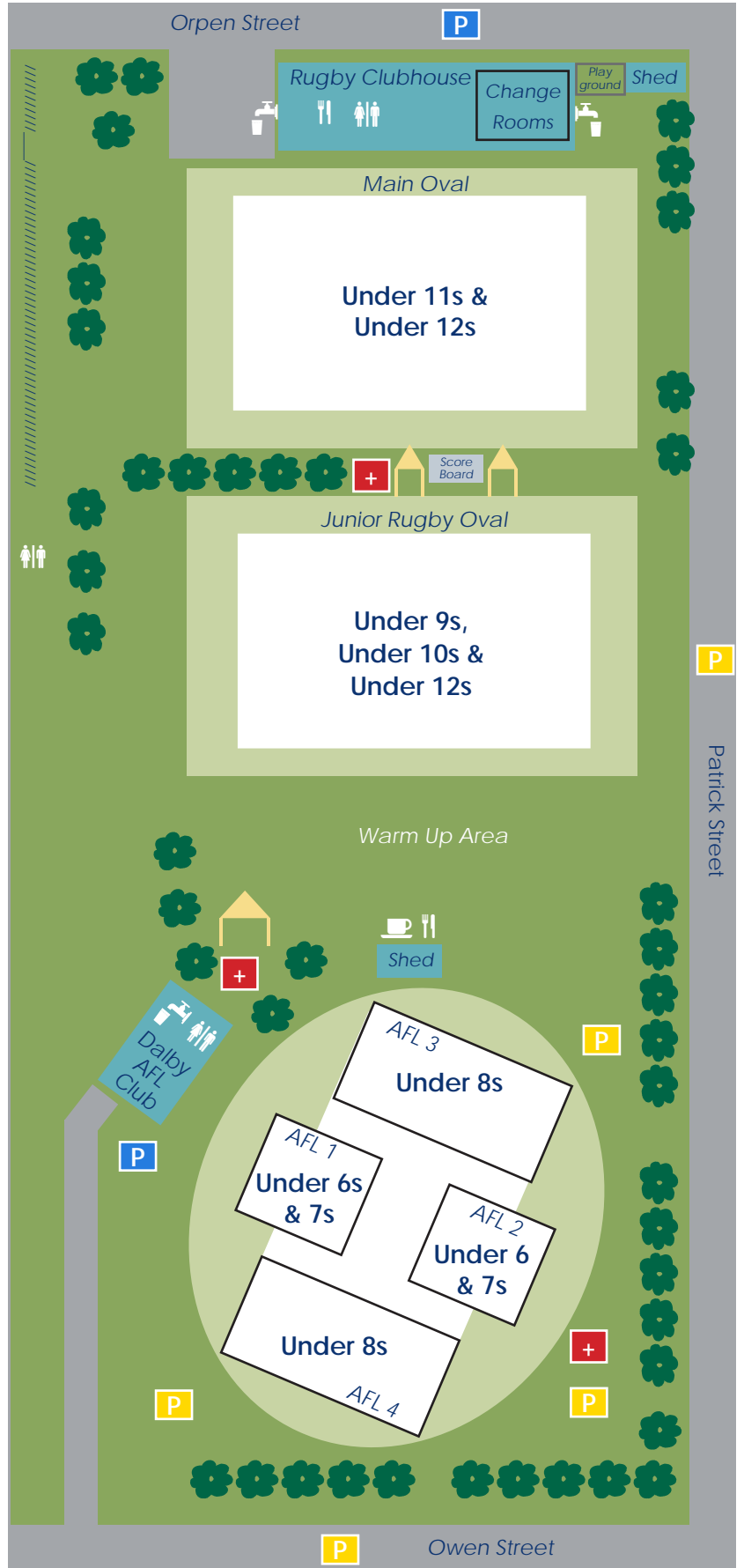


Dalby Rugby Races
